

Stage #3

Business Gone Bad

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2005
CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Required

COURSE DESIGNER: Jon Santini

STARTING POSITION: Seated at P1, hands on table, gun loaded to division capacity and spare ammo in box.

SCENARIO: While conducting a business transaction, you find your clients have set you up. You see that they have taken your 2 partners hostage and threaten to kill them if you don't give them the goods AND the money. The time for action is now, save your partners and your business.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At the start signal, turn, retrieve your gun from the box and engage all threats while seated with 2 shots each. Use tactical sequence for each pair of targets at the same distance.

Notes:

- Re-load only using a slide-lock reload as there is no cover available.
- Engage targets in Tactical Sequence paired at the same distance. T1 & T2, T3 & T4, T5 & T6, T7 & T8.

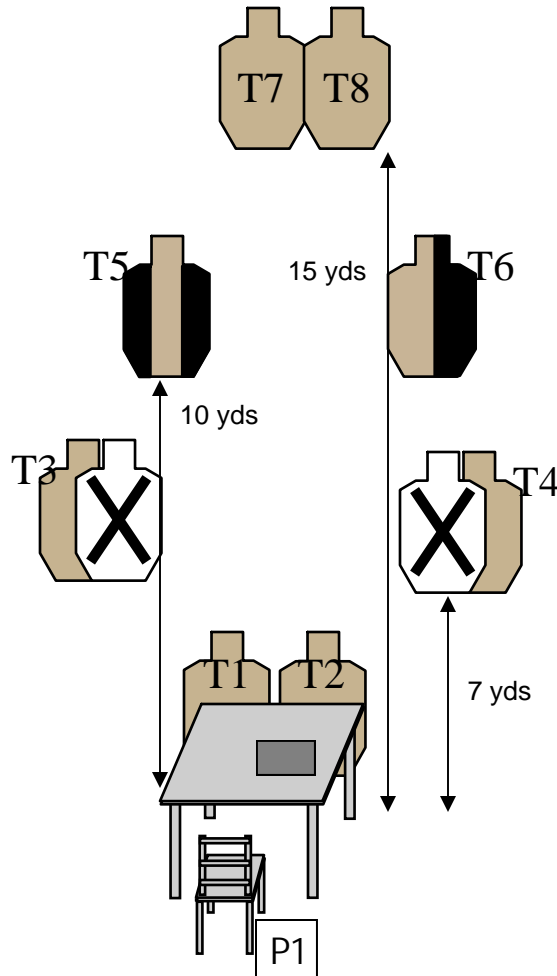
SCORING: Vickers Count

RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads

ROUND COUNT: 16 Minimum

START-STOP: Audible and last shot

SCORED HITS: Best 2 shots each on T1 - T8 each.
