Heads Up

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2005
CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Required

COURSE DESIGNER: Jon Santini

STARTING POSITION: Standing at P1, facing up-range, hands relaxed at sides, gun holstered and loaded to division capacity.

SCENARIO: While out on your evening walk with your spouse, you are attacked by the "Three Strikes Gang". You turn to see your spouse at gunpoint. You need to act quickly as more members of the gang are approaching. They take cover when the shooting starts.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At the start signal, turn, draw and engage T1 with 2 head shots and advance to P2 while engaging all remaining targets with 2 shots each. Targets may be engaged on the move or at the barricade.

Notes:

- Re-load as necessary using any IDPA re-load from behind cover only.
- Once you pass a target, you may not re-engage it.

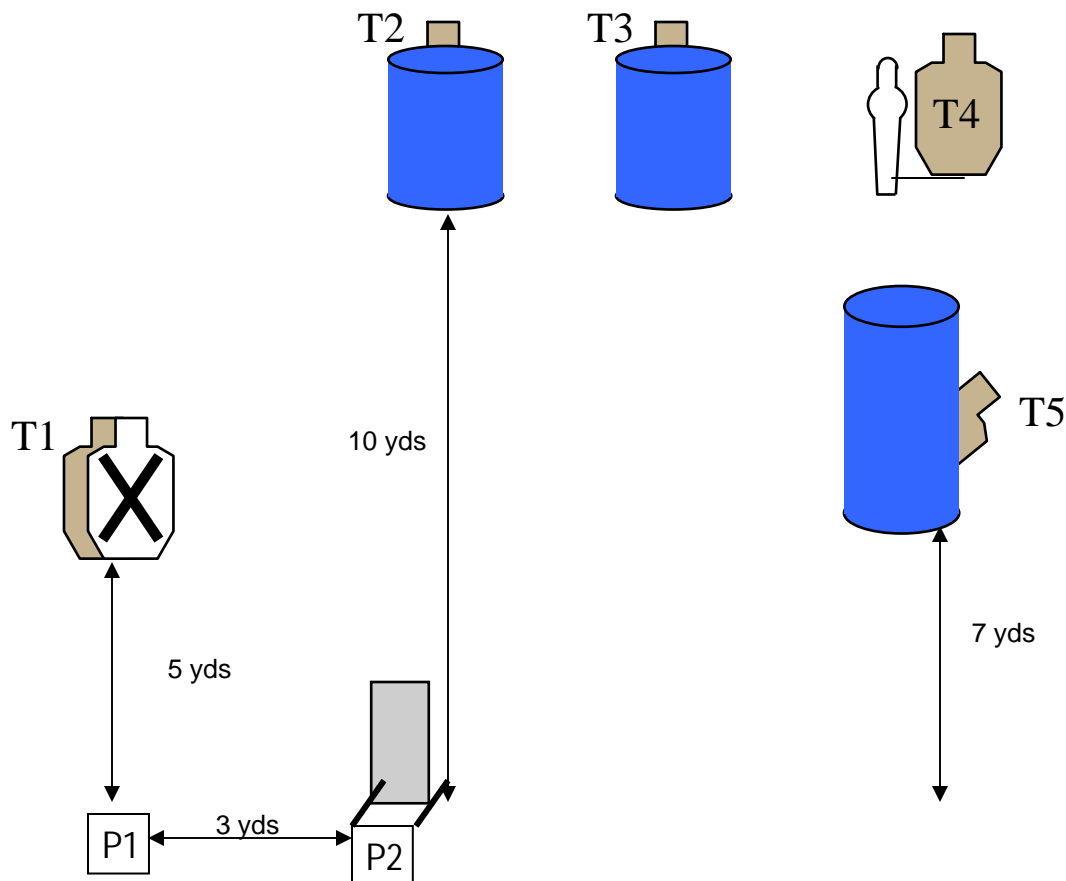
SCORING: Vickers Count

ROUND COUNT: 11 Minimum

SCORED HITS: Best 2 shots each on T1 - T5 each and knock down the popper.

RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads

START-STOP: Audible and last shot
