

Stage # 4

Knife Fight?

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2005
CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Required

COURSE DESIGNER: John Tinney modifies by Jon Santini

STARTING POSITION: Standing at P1, knife in strong hand and a piece of wood in assist hand, gun holstered and loaded to division capacity.

SCENARIO: While camping, you go into the woods to search for firewood. 6 redneck hilljacks and their pit bull appear from the heavy brush intent on making you a star in their version of "Deliverance." With your hands full of wood and a knife, make the best of a bad situation.... or squeal like a pig!!.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At the start signal, engage T1 with the knife (this is a scored hit, so make it count.). Advance to P2 and engage remaining threat targets T2-T7 with 2 shots each using cover appropriately.

Notes:

- Reload as necessary using any IPDA reload.
- The knife hit is scored as if it were a shot. If there is no hit, it will incur an FTN penalty.

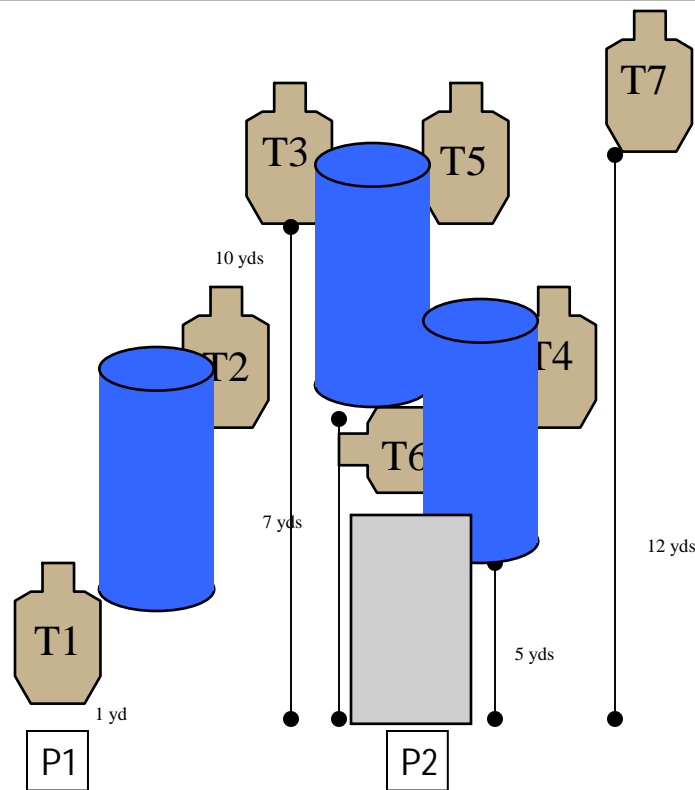
SCORING: Vickers Count

RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads

ROUND COUNT: 12 Minimum

START-STOP: Audible and last shot

SCORED HITS: Knife hit on T1, best 2 shots on T2-T6
