

Stage # 2

Trapped

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2005
CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Required

COURSE DESIGNER: Morgan Dague modified by Jon Santini

STARTING POSITION: Standing at P1, hand at sides, gun holstered and loaded to division capacity.

SCENARIO: Walking through a building, you are startled by gunfire. You draw your handgun attempt to retreat, but are forced to defend yourself when you realize you are trapped.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At the start signal, draw and knock down both steel and engage T1 with 2 shots through the window. Retreat to P2 and engage T2 - T4 with 2 shots each, strong hand only, using cover. Perform a tactical reload or reload with retention. Transition the gun to the assist hand, then engage T5 - T7 with 2 shots each, assist hand only, using cover.

Notes:

- Reload as necessary using any IPDA reload. Reload with both hands.
- T1 flips up when the left steel is knocked down.
- Only transition the gun 1 time. Shoot the strong side bank of targets first. Left hand shooters will reverse the sequence on T2-T7.
- Be careful not to expose yourself to the threats on the opposite side while using cover.

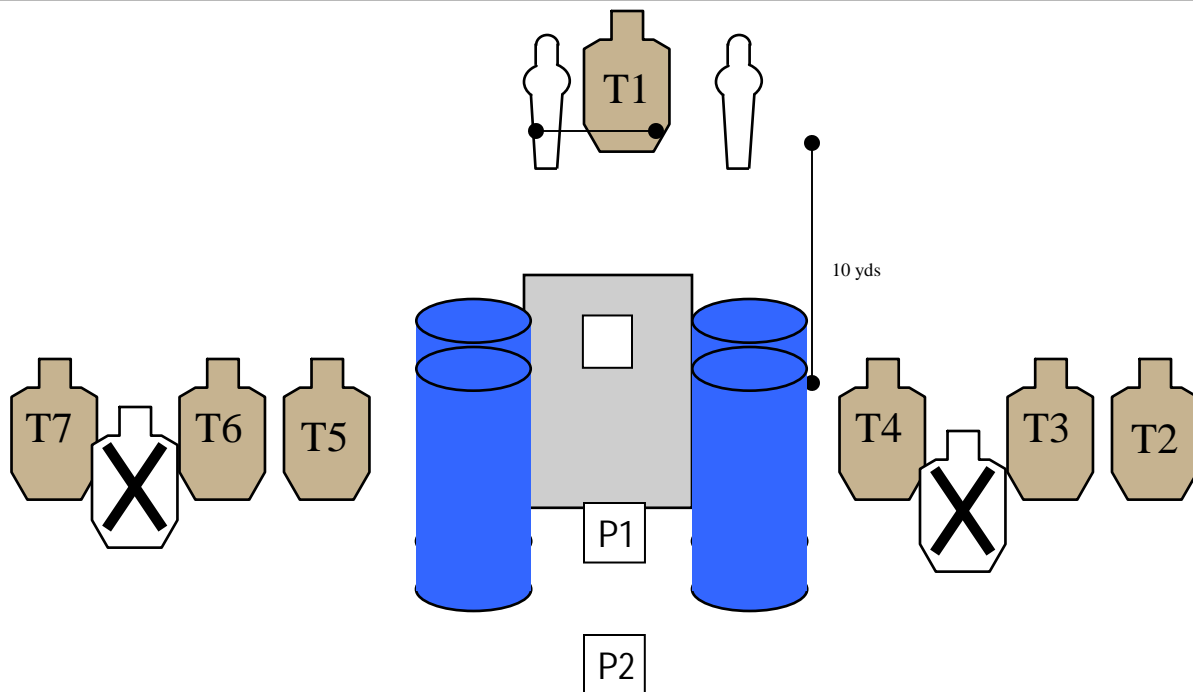
SCORING: Vickers Count

RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads

ROUND COUNT: 12 Minimum

START-STOP: Audible and last shot

SCORED HITS: Best 2 shots on T1-T7 and knock down steel
