

Stage #3

Compromised "Cleanup"

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2005
CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Required

COURSE DESIGNER: Jon Santini

STARTING POSITION: P1 facing downrange with clipboard in both hands. Firearm concealed.

SCENARIO: You are checking on a cleanup site with a clipboard in both hands. As you approach the fenced area, you realize that a co-worker is in trouble. Several bad guys are ready to ambush him. You must act quickly to protect your co-worker and yourself.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At the start signal, drop the clipboard, draw, and move to P2 on either side of the opening. Engage T1-T6 in tactical priority with 2 shots each using cover appropriately. Do not move across the opening; you must choose to shoot all shots from the left side or the right side. Reload as necessary from behind cover using any IDPA reloads.

- Start with the gun loaded to IDPA Division capacity.
- Any target may be re-engaged.
- All reloads must be done from behind cover.

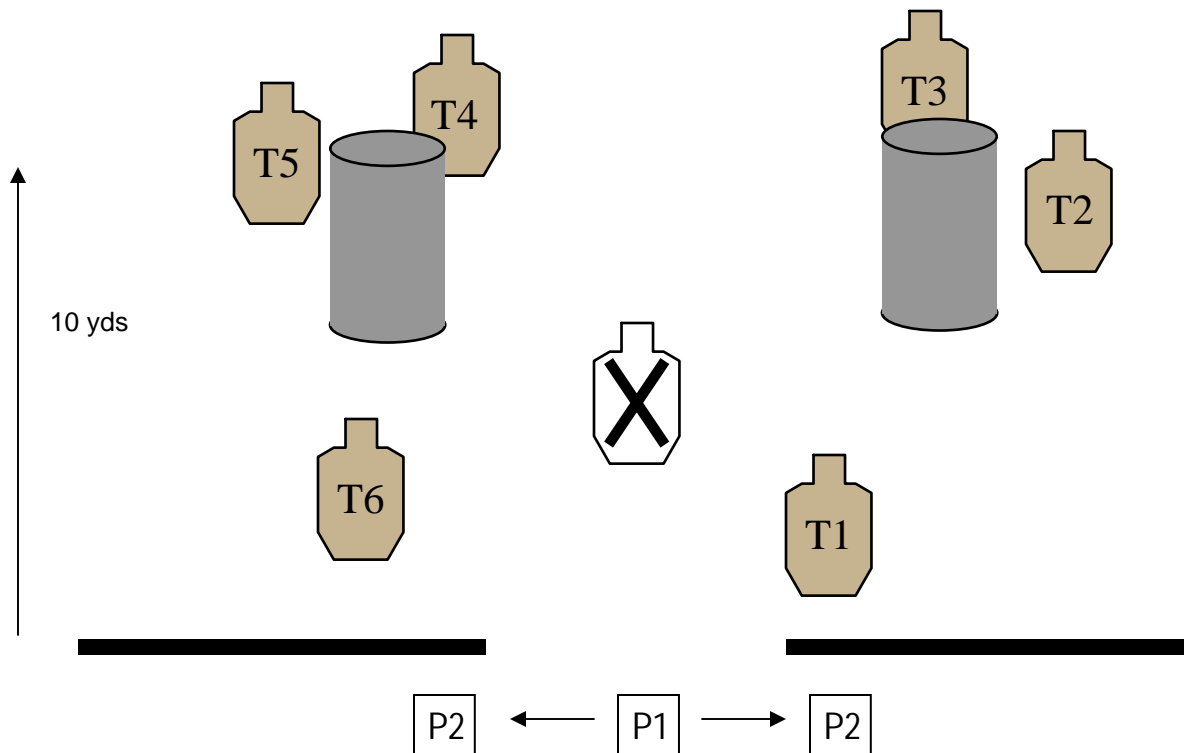
SCORING: Vickers Count

ROUND COUNT: 12 Minimum

SCORED HITS: Best 2 each on T1-T6

RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads

START-STOP: Audible & Last Shot
