

Stage #1

Nature Bites

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2006
CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Required

COURSE DESIGNER: Jon Santini

STARTING POSITION: P1 with hands at side. Firearm concealed.

SCENARIO: While taking a leisurely nature hike, you and your significant other find yourselves confronted by nature. A pack of hungry wolves thinks you look like a tasty morsel. You decide to take action and to protect the two of you. Although you are armed, your ammunition supply is limited and it is a long way back to civilization.

STAGE PROCEDURE: This stage contains 3 strings of fire.

String 1: Freestyle - Shooter begins at P1 with hands at sides and firearm concealed. On the Start signal, draw and engage T1 & T2 with 2 shots each in tactical sequence. Then engage T3 - T6 in tactical sequence with 2 shots each. Shots can be fired freestyle. Reload as necessary with any IDPA reload.

String 2: Strong Hand Only - Shooter begins at P1 with hands at side and firearm concealed. On the start signal, draw and engage T1 & T2 with 1 shot each strong hand only. Then engage T3 - T6 with 1 shot each strong hand only.

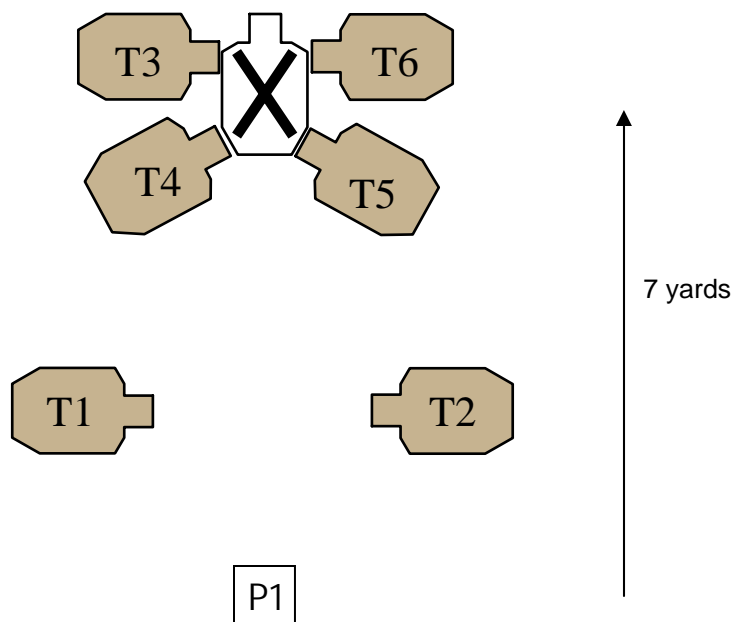
String 3: Weak Hand Only - Shooter begins at P1 with firearm in weak hand at low ready. On start signal, engage T1 & T2 with 1 shot each weak hand only. Then engage T3 - T6 with 1 shot each weak hand only.

Notes:

Each string will begin with the gun loaded to division maximum.
This stage is limited Vickers - so NO "make-up" shots.

SCORING: Limited Vickers
ROUND COUNT: 24
SCORED HITS: 4 each on T1-T6

RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads
START-STOP: Audible & Last Shot
STRINGS: 3
