

Stage #2

Save the Baby

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2005
CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Required

COURSE DESIGNER: Jon Santini

STARTING POSITION: Standing at P1, hands relaxed at sides, loaded to division capacity.

SCENARIO: While out on your morning jog, you come upon a woman pushing a stroller. Suddenly she is snatched and you hear her scream. Two armed thugs become visible and begin shooting. The stroller is in the line of fire. Save yourself, the baby and if possible the mother.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At the start signal, engage T1-T2 with 2 shots each in tactical priority. Advance to P2 and engage T3-T4 with 2 shots each in tactical priority. Push the stroller to knock down popper and activate the swinger. Move to P3 and engage T5-T7 with 2 shots in tactical priority.

Notes:

- Re-load as necessary using any IDPA re-load from cover only.
- Cover must be used appropriately.
- The stroller must knock down the popper to activate the swinger. If the swinger is not activated, it will stay behind the non-threat target and can not be engaged.
- Be aware of muzzle direction.

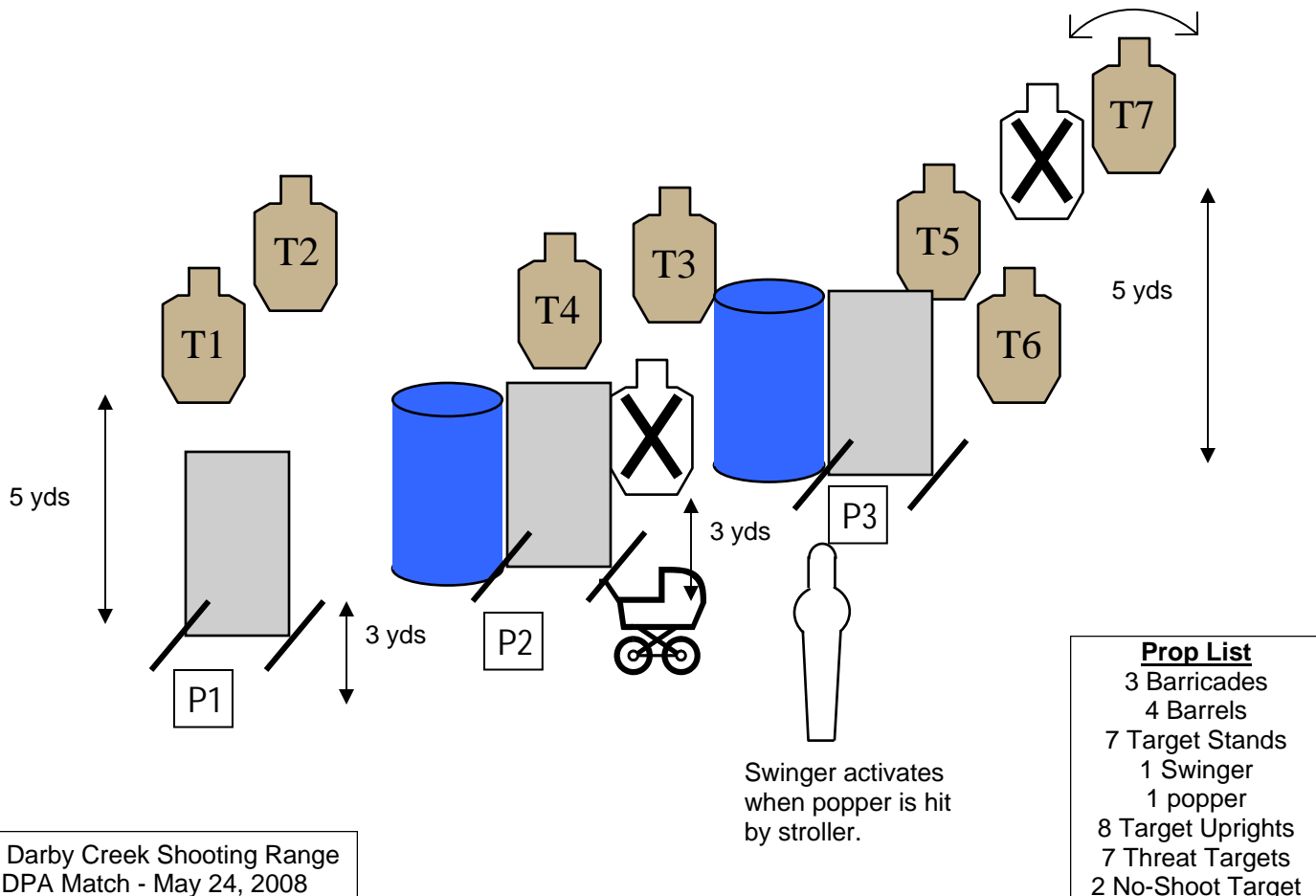
SCORING: Vickers Count

RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads

ROUND COUNT: 14 Minimum

START-STOP: Audible and last shot

SCORED HITS: Best 2 shots on each target.
