

Stage #1

Somebody Call 911 v.3

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2005
CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Optional

COURSE DESIGNER: TacticalShooters.com adapted by Michael Craig & Jon Santini version 3

STARTING POSITION: P1 lying in bed with gun on night stand. Newspaper over chest.

SCENARIO: The bad guys have gotten the drop on you. You awaken to find 3 crazed intruders in your bedroom about to attack. Your gun is on the nightstand next to you, but because you have kids, you have decided not to fully load the gun. Not knowing how many bad guys are in your house, you decide to get your extra ammo out of the closet behind you once the shooting starts.

STAGE PROCEDURE: Place your gun on the nightstand with the magazine in the gun, but **NOT** locked into place. (Revolver shooters—load cylinder, but do not lock the cylinder into the frame.) Once the gun is in place, lie on your back on the bed with the newspaper covering your chest (P1). On the start signal, stand (P2) and while facing downrange retrieve your gun, load it, and engage T1-T3 with 2 shots each in Tactical Priority while retreating to the closet (P3). Retrieve and stow your extra magazines. Move to the doorway (P4) of your kid's room and clear the room engaging T4-T8 with 2 shots each.

- While retreating to the closet, you must keep the muzzle pointed downrange.
- Reload as necessary from behind cover. Lock the Mag in the gun before moving. Any IDPA reload is acceptable.
- You must use cover when it is available.
- All ammo used in this stage **MUST** start in the gun or from the magazines retrieved from the closet.

SCORING: Vickers Count

RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads

ROUND COUNT: 16 Minimum

START-STOP: Audible & Last Shot

SCORED HITS: Best 2 each on T1-T8
