

Stage #2

Near then Far

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2005
CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Required

COURSE DESIGNER: Jon Santini

STARTING POSITION: Standing at P1, hands at sides, gun holstered and loaded to division capacity.

SCENARIO: While leaving work late one night, you are accosted by an angry former co-worker who has brought his posse to cause some havoc. They pull their guns as they grab you and you react. This gets the attention of the posse and they start shooting. Defend yourself.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At the start signal, draw and engage T1-T2 from retention with 2 rounds each remaining stationary. Move to cover at P2 and engage T3-T5 and the popper in tactical priority with 2 rounds each.

Notes:

- Re-load as necessary using any IDPA re-load.
- Do NOT shoot the popper on the move to P2.

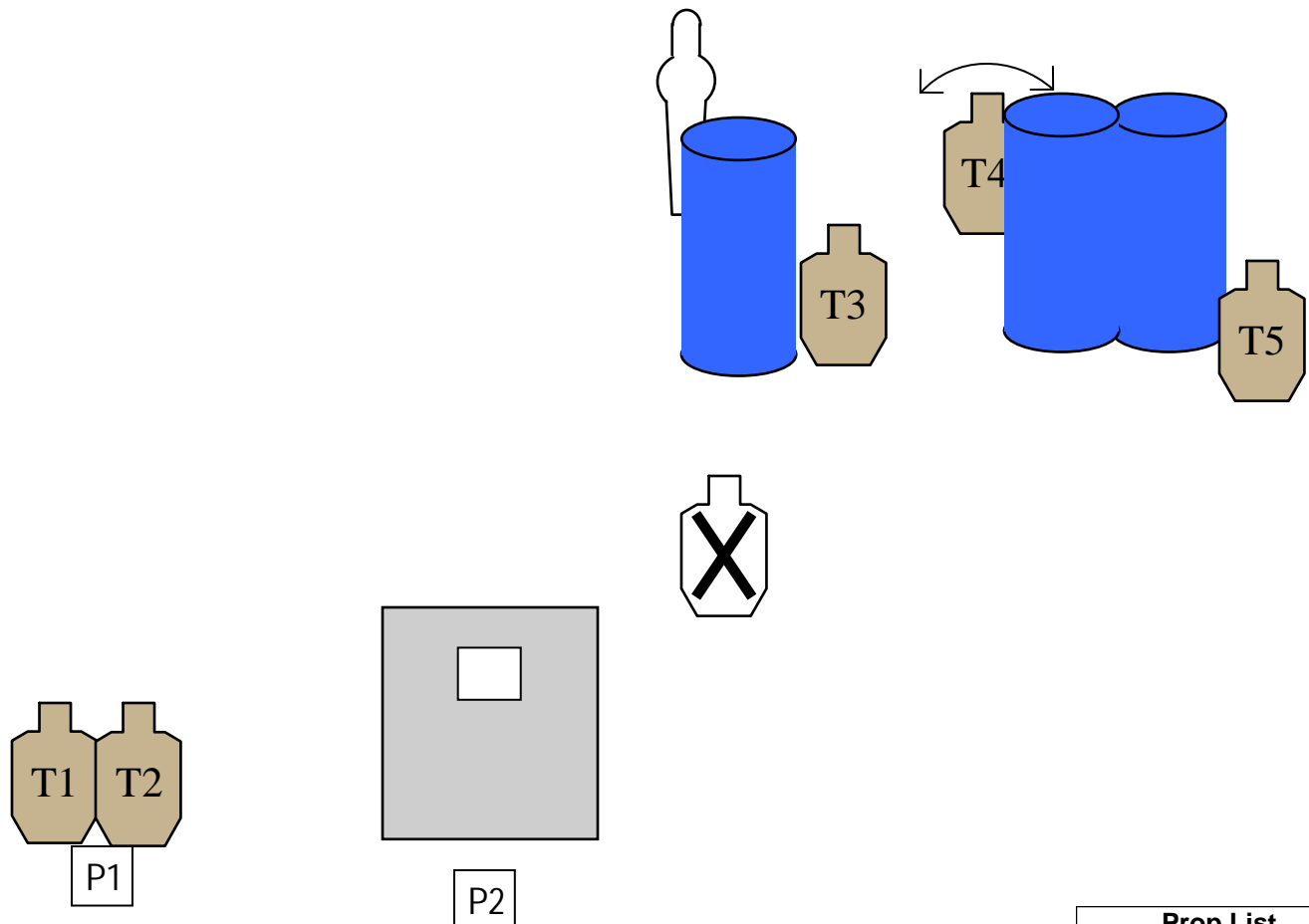
SCORING: Vickers Count

ROUND COUNT: 11 Minimum

SCORED HITS: Best 2 shots per target

RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads

START-STOP: Audible and last shot
