Circus No More

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2005
CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Required

COURSE DESIGNER: Russ Pedersen

STARTING POSITION: Standing at P1, leash in strong hand, gun holstered and loaded to division capacity.

SCENARIO: While traveling on a rural road, you come upon a minivan moving slowly in the same direction. Waiting for a chance to pass, you observe the driver passing to a child in the back seat what appears to be a toy handgun. A smile comes to your face as you remember your first toy handgun and all those times you played cowboys and Indians and gangsters vs the g-man. You pass and move on down the road. You come upon a rural rest stop and decide to walk to dog. Returning to your car, you find the van blocking your exit. What was earlier thought to be a mom and her children is actually a band of vicious former circus performing gypsy dwarf midgets and their leader... the bearded lady. They are armed and wearing bullet-proof vests.

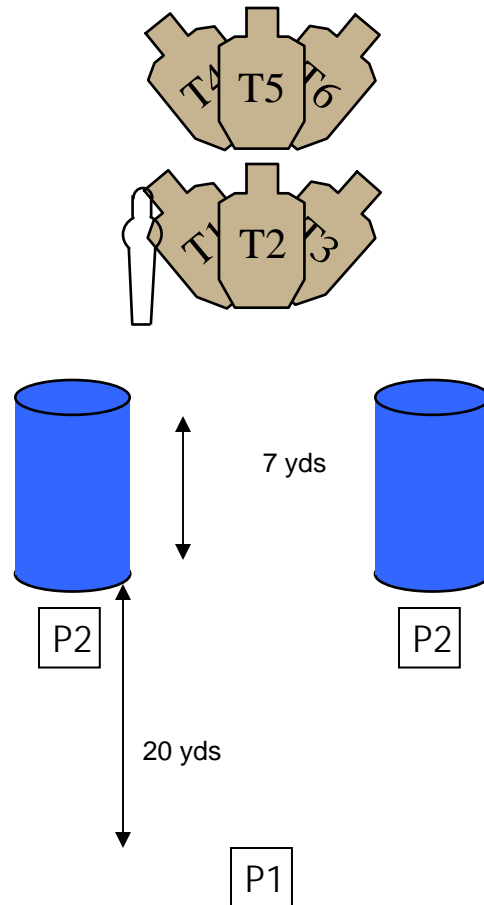
STAGE PROCEDURE: Starting at P1, drop the leash, draw and engage the popper. While moving to cover at either P2, engage each target with 1 shot to each head while advancing to P2. Once at P2, re-engage each target with 1 additional head shot.

Notes:

- Re-load as necessary using any IDPA re-load.
- Target array MUST be engaged while moving.
- If P2 is reached before each initial head shot is taken, establish cover and engage the targets in tactical sequence (slicing the pie). If a target had not been engaged while moving, then put 2 shots on before engaging the next target. Remember to use cover when it becomes available.

SCORING: Vickers Count
ROUND COUNT: 13 Minimum
SCORED HITS: Best 2 head shots on paper and knock down popper.

RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads
START-STOP: Audible and last shot
