

Stage # 4

Not So Friendly Conversation

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2005
CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Required

COURSE DESIGNER: Jon Santini

STARTING POSITION: Sitting on chair at P1, hands on table, gun holstered and loaded to division capacity.

SCENARIO: While engaged in what you thought was a friendly business conversation, the situation turns hostile and you realize you have been set up. Defend yourself and get out of there.

STAGE PROCEDURE: At the start signal, stand and draw engaging T1 with 6 shots strong hand only while retreating to cover at P2. At P2 drop the briefcase and engage T2 with 2 shots any way you want.

Notes:

- Reload as necessary using any IPDA reload.
- Be careful not to trip on the chair while retreating.
- Be sure to bring the briefcase with you to P2. Weak hand carry. A procedural error will be assessed if it is left behind.

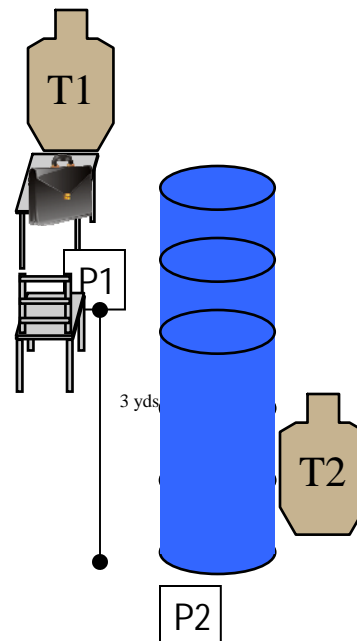
SCORING: Vickers Count

RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads

ROUND COUNT: 8 Minimum

START-STOP: Audible and last shot

SCORED HITS: Best 6 shots on T1 & 2 shots on T2
