

## Stage #2

## In Your Face

**RULES:** IDPA Rule Book 2005  
**CONCEALMENT GARMENT:** Required

**COURSE DESIGNER:** Jon Santini

**STARTING POSITION:** Standing at P1, hands relaxed at sides, gun holstered and loaded to division capacity.

**SCENARIO:** You are waiting for a friend who appears to be late. When you peer into the window, you see why. Your friend is being held at gunpoint. Get rid of the bad guys so you and your friend can get away.

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** At the start signal, draw and engage the popper until down and T1-T5 with 2 shots each. Advance to either P2 and engage T6 or T7 with 2 shots. Move to the other P2 and engage the final target with 2 shots.

Notes:

- Re-load as necessary using any IDPA re-load. Do not leave cover with an empty gun.
- The popper and T1-T5 can be engaged in any order.
- The popper activates the T4 swinger. When the swinger stops, it is not visible so it will not score an FTN.
- T5 will flip up when the popper is knocked down.

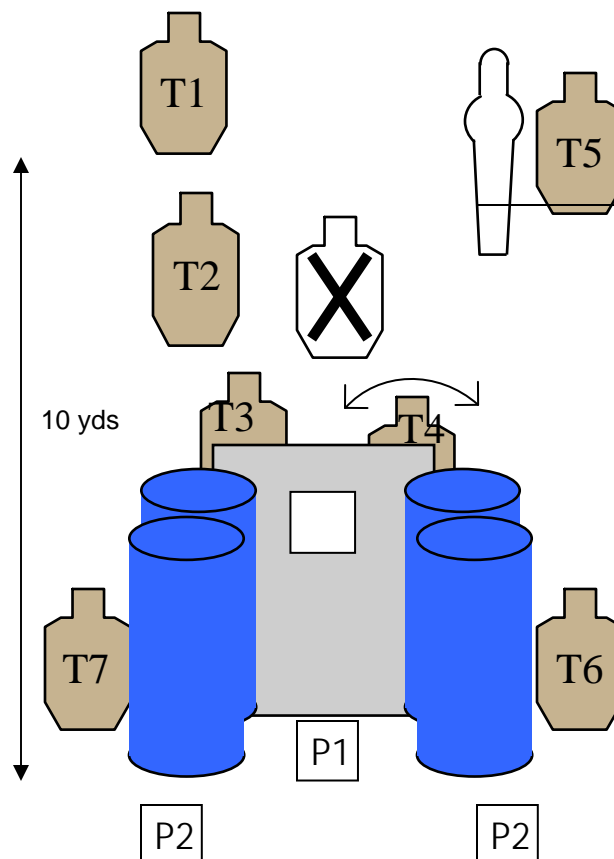
**SCORING:** Vickers Count

**RELOADS:** Any IDPA reloads

**ROUND COUNT:** 15 Minimum

**START-STOP:** Audible and last shot

**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 shots on paper and knock down steel

- 7 Threat Targets
- 1 Non-Threat Target
