

Stage #4

Mucho El Presidente

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2005
CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Required

COURSE DESIGNER: Jon Santini

STARTING POSITION: Standing at P1, facing up range, hands relaxed at sides, gun holstered.

SCENARIO: This stage includes various modifications on the El Presidente. There are 3 strings of fire.

STAGE PROCEDURE:

String 1: Begin at P1 (3 yards) loaded to division capacity. At the start signal, turn, draw and engage T1-T3 with 2 head shots each in tactical priority (1-1-2-1-1).

String 2: Begin at P2 (5 yards) loaded to division capacity. At the start signal, turn, draw and engage T1-T3 with 2 head shots each in tactical priority (1-1-2-1-1).

String 3: Begin at P3 (10 yards) loaded with 6 rounds in the gun. At the start signal, turn, draw and engage T1-T3 with 2 body shots each in tactical priority (1-1-2-1-1). Perform a slide-lock reload and re-engage with 2 body shots in tactical priority (1-1-2-1-1). Re-engage again with 1 head shot each.

Notes:

- Re-load only as dictated by the string unless there is a malfunction.
- After String 2, paste all body shots. Only head shots count. Any body shots are considered a miss in Strings 1 & 2.
- This is a Limited Vickers stage, so there are no extra shots. Each extra shot is a procedural and the best shot(s) on the target is(are) taken away.
- On String 3, any shooter who cannot reload with at least 9 rounds (CDP, revolver, & those using lower capacity mags) may reload as needed after the initial 6 shot slide-lock reload. Failure to reload for the final shot(s) will result in a FTDR penalty (20 seconds).

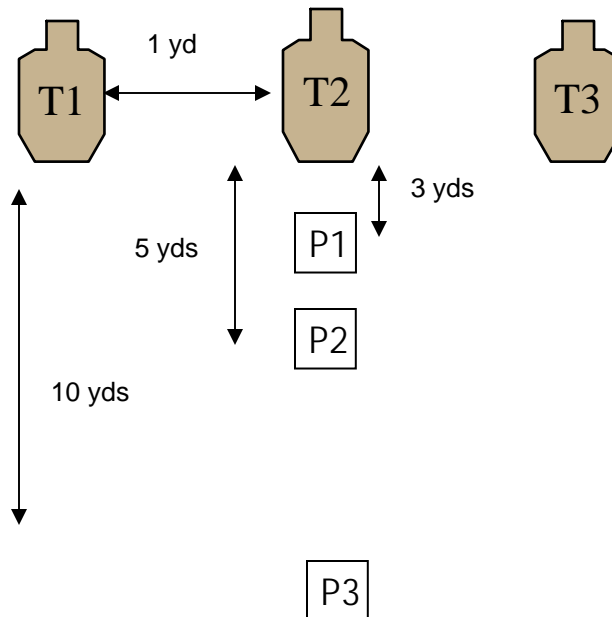
SCORING: Limited Vickers

ROUND COUNT: 27

SCORED HITS: 9 shots on paper - 4 body shots & 5 head shots

RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads

START-STOP: Audible and last shot
