

Stage # 3

Close Encounter

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2005
CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Required

COURSE DESIGNER: Jon Santini

STARTING POSITION: Standing at P1, arms length from the non-threats, hands relaxed at sides, loaded to division capacity.

SCENARIO: While having a civilized discussion, you realize part of your group is not in agreement and decide to get a little rough and blaze away at the opposition. Defend yourself and those who agree with you. Cover is available, but getting to it is a little dangerous.

STAGE PROCEDURE: Start at P1 with your hands relaxed at your sides. At the start signal, draw and engage T1-T3 with 2 shots each in any order. Advance toward P2 engaging T4 on the way with 2 shots to the body while moving. At P2, engage T5-T6 with 2 shots to each body and 1 shot to each head in tactical priority using cover.

Notes:

- Reload as necessary using any IPDA reload from cover only.
- T4 must be engaged on the move, but can be re-engaged at P2.

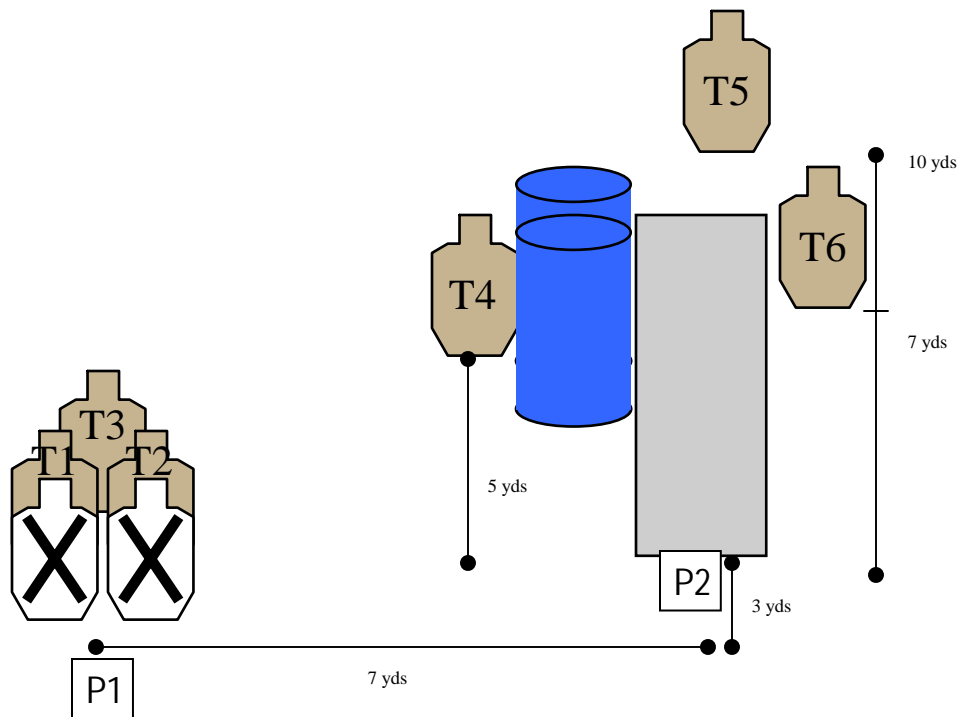
SCORING: Vickers Count

RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads

ROUND COUNT: 15 Minimum

START-STOP: Audible and last shot

SCORED HITS: Best 2 shots on T1-T4, best 2 body shots and 1 head shot on T5-T6.
