

Stage # 4

How Many Rounds?

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2005
CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Required

COURSE DESIGNER: Unknown (saw it on a YouTube video), modified by Jon Santini.

STARTING POSITION: Standing at P1, hands relaxed at sides, down-loaded to a random capacity less than 9 rounds for each string.

SCENARIO: This is 2 strings of Standards - Freestyle & Strong Hand Only.

STAGE PROCEDURE: There are 2 strings of fire in this stage. At the beginning of each string, the shooter will hand the SO the starting magazine. The SO will remove a random number of rounds (A reload must be forced so the SO must ensure there are no more than 8 rounds in the magazine).

String 1: Start at P1 with your hands relaxed at your sides. At the start signal, draw and engage T1-T3 with 2 shots to the body in tactical sequence (i.e. 1-1-2-1-1) followed by 1 shot to each head FREESTYLE.

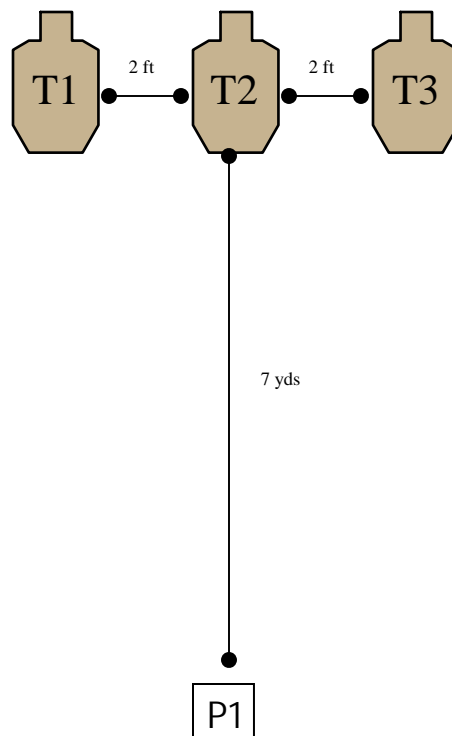
String 2: Start at P1 with your hands relaxed at your sides. At the start signal, draw and engage T1-T3 with 2 shots to the body in tactical sequence (i.e. 1-1-2-1-1) followed by 1 shot to each head STONG HAND ONLY.

Notes:

- Reload from slide lock only.
- SO will remove a random number of rounds from the magazine. A reload must be done on each string so there can not be more than 8 rounds in the magazine.
- DO NOT shoot all 18 rounds to the head. This will result in a procedural for each string.

SCORING: Limited Vickers
ROUND COUNT: 18 (9 per string)
SCORED HITS: 4 required total body shots & 2 required total head shots on each target.

RELOADS: Slide lock reloads only
START-STOP: Audible and last shot
