

## Stage # 2

## Walk This Aisle

**RULES:** IDPA Rule Book 2005  
**CONCEALMENT GARMENT:** Required

**COURSE DESIGNER:** Jon Santini

**STARTING POSITION:** Standing at P1, facing up range, hands relaxed at sides, loaded to division capacity.

**SCENARIO:** This isn't your wedding day, but it feels like it could be. The bad guys are everywhere. You need to get down this aisle to save your spouse and best friend. You only wish there were more friendlies and fewer thugs.

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** Start at P1 facing up range with your hands relaxed at your sides. At the start signal, turn and draw. Advance toward P2 and engage T1-T6 along the way with 2 shots each. (One of the targets (T1-T6) will be a non-threat designated randomly by the SO while the shooter is in the ready position.) At P2, engage T7-T9 with 2 shots each in tactical sequence from either side of the non-threat targets.

**Notes:**

- Reload as necessary using any IPDA reload from cover only.
- The non-threat in the aisle will be randomly established by the SO once the shooter is in the start position.
- All targets are at or below the barrel height.

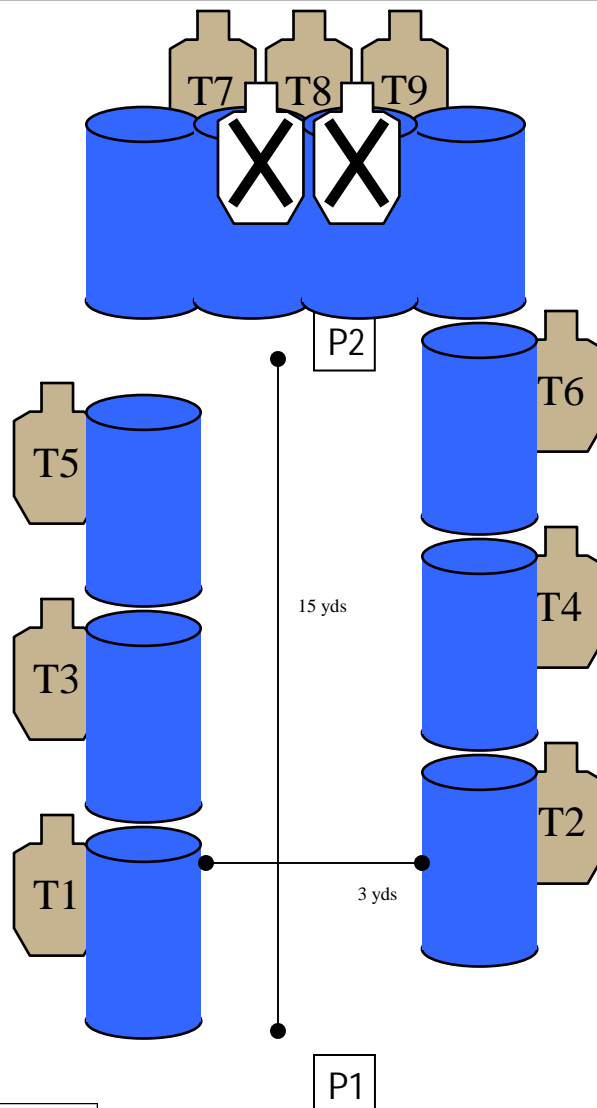
**SCORING:** Vickers Count

**RELOADS:** Any IDPA reloads

**ROUND COUNT:** 16 Minimum

**START-STOP:** Audible and last shot

**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 shots each target.

- 10 Single Barrels
- 11 Target Stands
- 22 Short Uprights
- 9 Threat Targets
- 2 No-Shoot Targets
- 1 Set No-Shoot Hands
