

STAGE 2 Bay 2	Seek Cover while using Concealment Designed by Roger Tate
RULES: IDPA– Concealment required	STARTING POSITION: Hands on top of “car”
SCENARIO: You have just left you local stop & rob and while getting into your car, you are attacked by a roving gang. Being a avid defensive pistol shooter, you know that cars my provide concealment, but poor cover. With this in mind , you engage the multiple threats while retreating to the cover of a brick wall of the store	STAGE PROCEDURE: On Signal, engage all targets as you see them while moving to the “brick” wall. Do not expose yourself to any unengaged targets. Paper targets get 2 rds each, steel must fall
SCORING: Vickers Count ROUND COUNT: 18 minimum TARGET DISTANCE: 2– 15 yards SCORED HITS: Best 2 on paper, steel must fall	SAFETY ISSUES: watch muzzle direction while moving SPECIAL NOTES: START-STOP: Audible & Last shot RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads behind cover. Low cover is at least 1 knee on ground
