# For Whom the Bell Tolls

**RULES:** IDPA Rule Book 2005  
**CONCEALMENT GARMENT:** Required

**COURSE DESIGNER:** Curt Nichols—2009 National Championship

**STARTING POSITION:** Standing at P1, facing T1, briefcase in strong hand, loaded to division capacity.

**SCENARIO:** You are headed home from a long day at the office when kidnapers attempt to snatch you for a juicy ransom. Defend yourself.

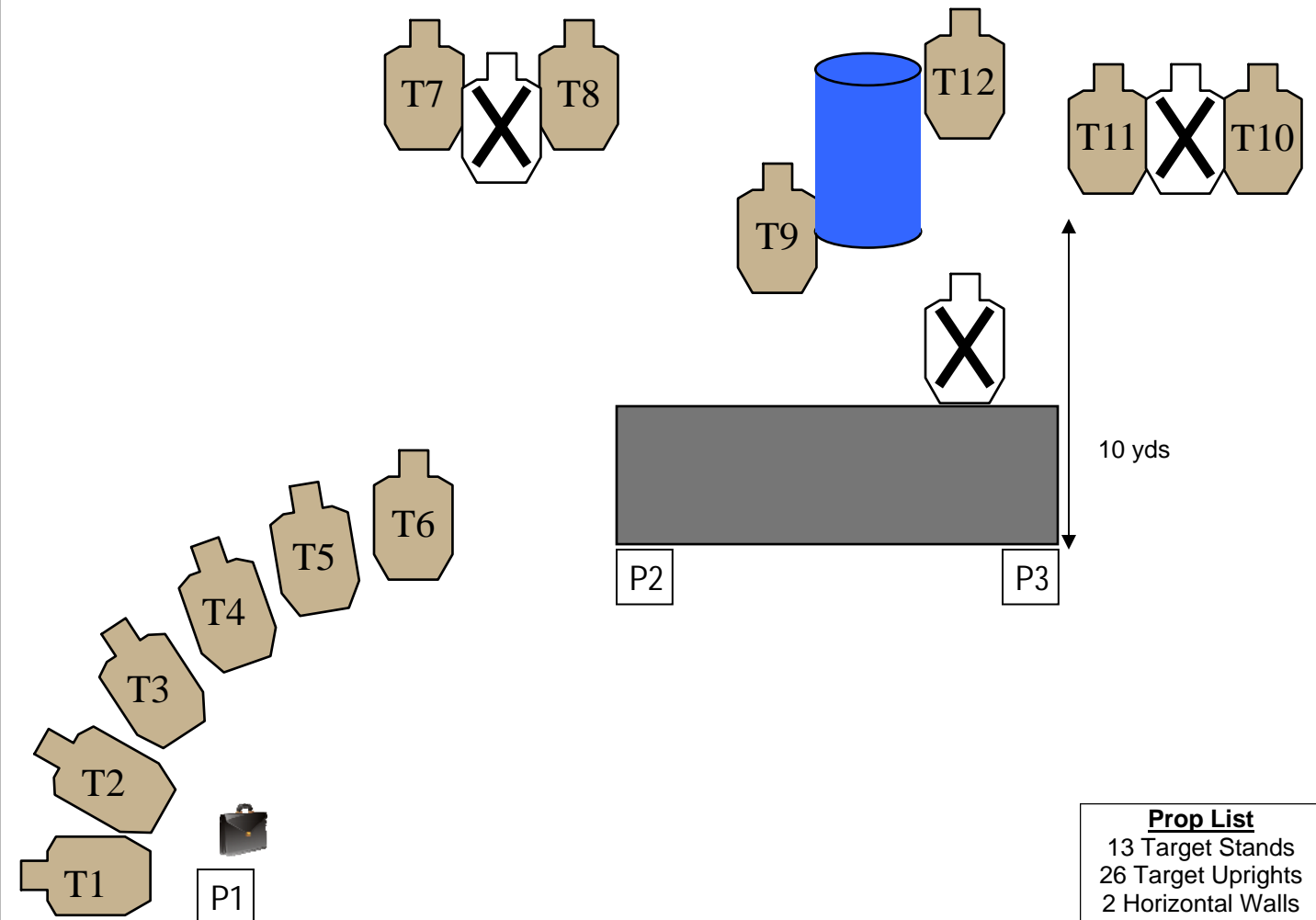
**STAGE PROCEDURE:** At the start signal, draw and engage T1—T6 in tactical priority with 1 round each. Move to P2 and engage T7-T9 in tactical priority with a minimum of 2 rounds each. Move to P3 and engage T10—T12 in tactical priority with a minimum of 2 rounds each.

Notes:

- Re-load as necessary using any IDPA re-load from behind cover only.
- T1-T6 may be shot on the move or stationary at P1.
- Shooter must finish engagement at P3, T7-T9 may not be re-engaged from P3.

**SCORING:** Vickers Count  
**ROUND COUNT:** 18 Minimum  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 1 shot on T1-T6 and best 2 shots on T7-T12.

**RELOADS:** Any IDPA reloads  
**START-STOP:** Audible and last shot
