

# Stage #3

# Bad Dog, No Biscuit

**RULES:** IDPA Rule Book 2005  
**CONCEALMENT GARMENT:** Required

**COURSE DESIGNER:** Ken Reed—2008 National Championship

**STARTING POSITION:** Standing at P1, hands relaxed at sides, loaded to division capacity.

**SCENARIO:** You are walking along a familiar street when you are attacked by a large dog. Save yourself! The owner of the dog and his brothers are across the street and see you fend off the dog. These three get their guns and begin firing on you.

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** At the start signal, draw and engage T1—T3 with 1 shot each and engage T4 with 3 shots. Move to P2 and engage T3—T7 with 3 rounds each.

Notes:

- Re-load as necessary using any IDPA re-load from behind cover only.
- P2 is using low cover - at least 1 knee must be on the ground

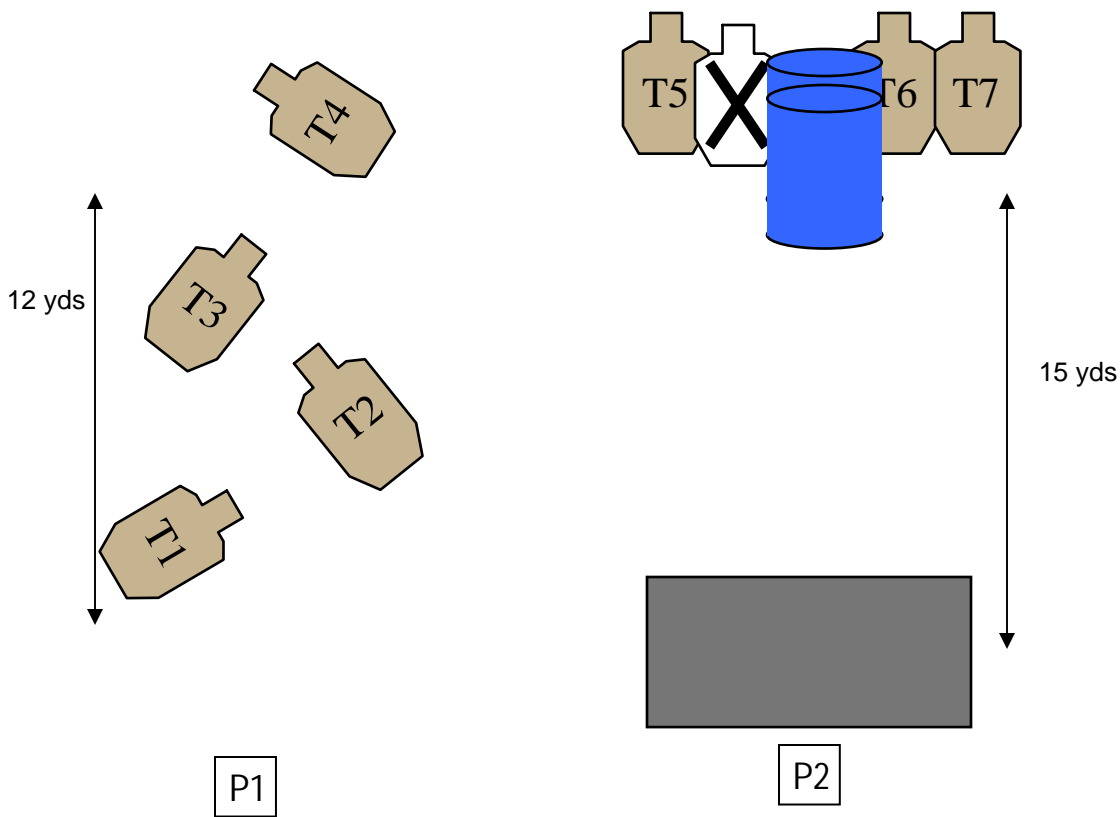
**SCORING:** Vickers Count

**RELOADS:** Any IDPA reloads

**ROUND COUNT:** 15 Minimum

**START-STOP:** Audible and last shot

**SCORED HITS:** Best 1 shot on T1-T3 and best 3 shots on T4-T7.
