I Love the Night Life

RULES: IDPA Rule Book 2005
CONCEALMENT GARMENT: Required

COURSE DESIGNER: 2007 IDPA Nationals Stage 11 Bay 6,
modified by Jon Santini

STARTING POSITION: Standing at P1, hands relaxed at sides, facing up range, and loaded to division capacity.

SCENARIO: Stopping by the night club where your sister works, you see things are terribly wrong. Two armed men guard the entrance to the back room and there are scream and gunshots coming from within. With an active shooting going on, you decide to intercede and rescue your sister.

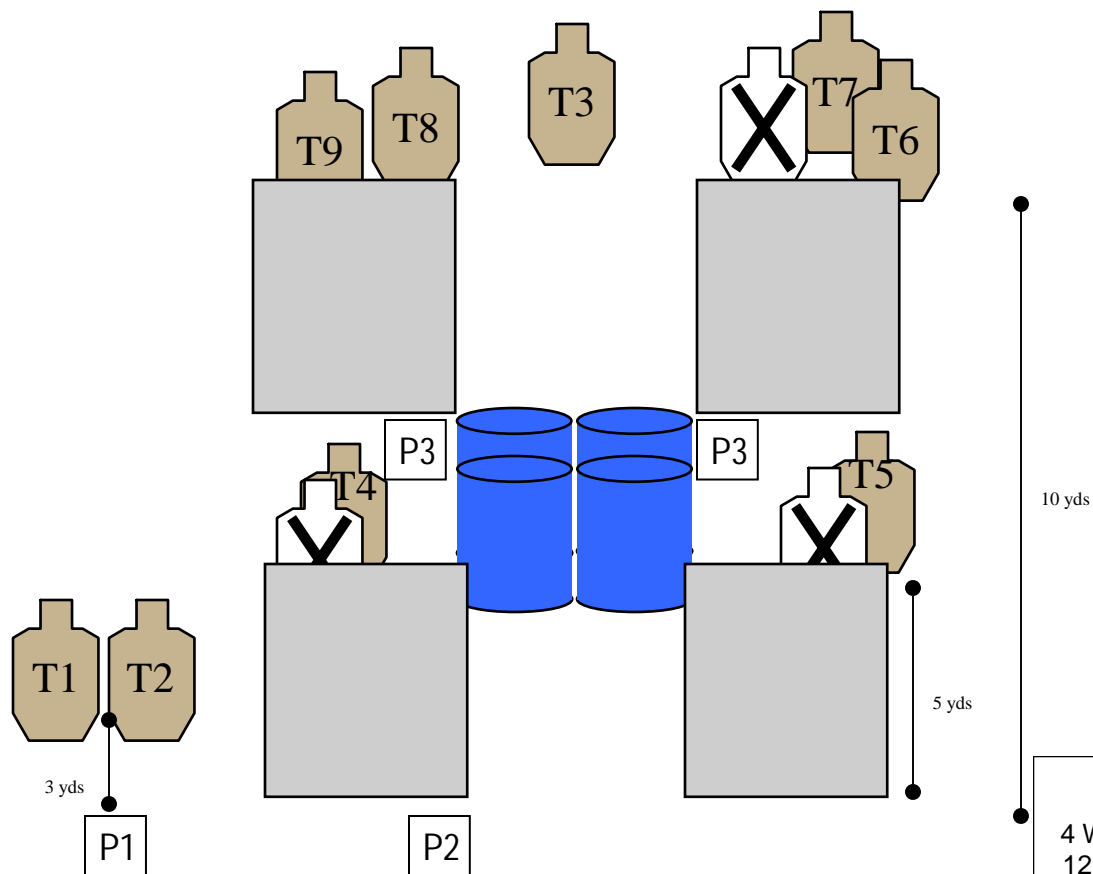
STAGE PROCEDURE: Start at P1 with your hands relaxed at your sides facing up range. At the start signal, turn and draw and engage T1-T2 with 2 shots each in tactical sequence while moving to cover. Advance toward P2 engaging T3-T5 with 2 shots each from cover. Advance to P3 by going around either side of the barrels. Engage T6-T9 with 2 shots each using cover appropriately.

Notes:

- Reload as necessary using any IPDA reload from cover only.
- Keep in mind T3 will be engage early in the stage. You may re-engage it at any time.

SCORING: Vickers Count
ROUND COUNT: 18 Minimum
SCORED HITS: Best 2 shots on T1-T9

RELOADS: Any IDPA reloads
START-STOP: Audible and last shot
