

# STAGE 5 BAY 8

# Pistol/Rifle

# “On Center”

**RULES:** USPSA MultiGun, Latest Edition

**COURSE DESIGNER:** Michael Craig

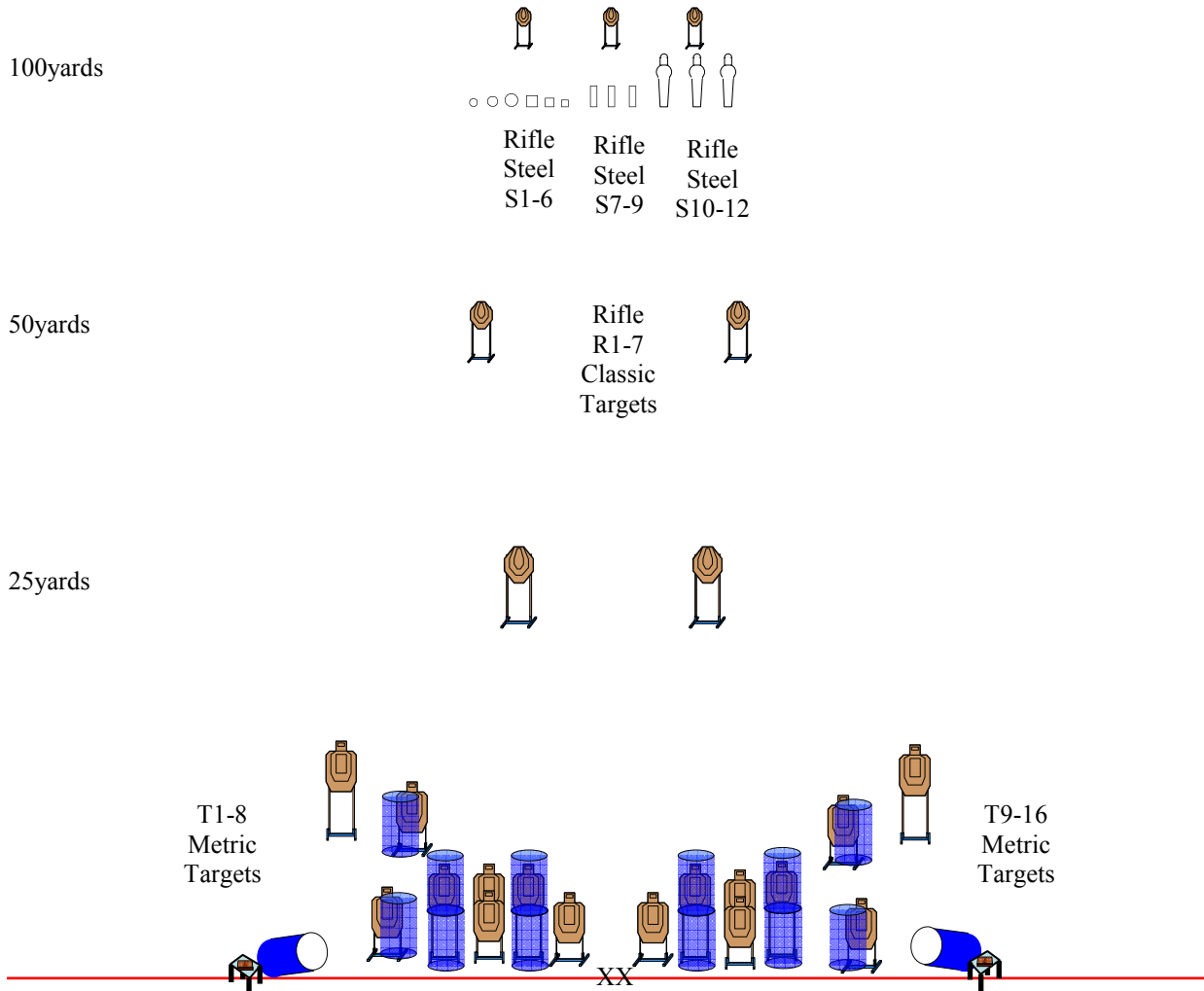
**START POSITION:** Handgun & Rifle loaded per 8.1 with rifle in barrel of choice and handgun in gun box of choice per MG10.5.3. Hands touching pistol box. **REMINDER-NO STEEL CORE BULLETS-CHECK WITH MAGNET.**

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** Upon start signal engage all targets as they become visible from behind fault line.

- All steel & paper rifle targets must be engaged from center of stage marked with XX's.
- R1-7 Classic targets are to be engaged freestyle.
- Rifle Steel S1-6 Circle & Square steel must be engaged from PRONE.
- Rifle S7-9 Rectangles "A" zone targets must be engaged from the KNEELING position only .
- Rifle Poppers must be engaged from the STANDING position only.
- Metric targets T1-16 must be engaged with pistol freestyle.
- When finished with one firearm you must ground it in gun box (pistol) or gun barrel (rifle) unloaded or in a safe condition before retrieving 2nd firearm.
- Rifle steel has an enhanced value of 10points each.

**SCORING:** Comstock 350 points  
**ROUNDS:** Rifle-26 Pistol-32  
**TARGETS:** IPSC23, Steel 12  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per IPSC,  
 Steel down = 2A's (10pts each)  
**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot

**REMINDER: NO STEEL CORE BULLETS TO BE USED ON STEEL TARGETS. THERE ARE 12 STEEL TARGETS IN THIS STAGE. DAMAGE TO STEEL WITH RESULT IN A FINE ON A TARGET BY TARGET BASIS. THIS STEEL COSTS OVER \$700. A MAGNET HAS BEEN PROVIDED TO R.O. TO CHECK AMMO. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE LEAD CORE BULLETS **DO NOT SHOOT** THE STEEL WITH RIFLE STEEL CORE AMMO.**
