

STAGE #1

Family Jewels part II

RULES: IDPA with concealment

Course Designer: J. Henry

STARTING POSITION: P1 Hands and "jewels" on table. Pistol loaded to Div. capacity.

SCENARIO: Your family keeps a large collection of heirlooms in a high-tech storage facility. On the way back from the appraiser, you happen upon a take over robbery in progress. Escape with the Family Jewels intact...or suffer the penalty(s)...

STAGE PROCEDURE: Begin at P1, hands and jewels on table. At signal, engage T1-T3 with 2 shots each in Tactical Sequence. Shoot out Emergency Light by knocking over plate. Plate must fall before you move to P2. Move to P2 w/ jewels & engage T4-T6 with 2 shots each. Move to P3 w/jewels & engage T7 & T8 with 2 shots to the head.

SCORING: Vickers Count

ROUND COUNT: 17 rounds minimum

SCORED HITS: Best 2 hits on each paper target. Scored plate. T7-T8 are head shots. A procedural will be assessed for each shooting position with no jewels. Any intentional modification to the "jewel box" will result in a FTDR.

RELOADS: Any legal reload using proper cover

START-STOP: Audible & Last shot
